## Frequently Asked Questions

- Q. Who can represent me before IRS?  
A. Generally, a person must be an Enrolled Agent, CPA, or attorney.
- Q. Can I do an Offer in Compromise (OIC)?  
A. You must qualify for an OIC. We would gather financial information to determine if you qualify. The IRS only approves about 1/3 of OICs submitted.
- Q. Are there any other solutions besides an Offer in Compromise?  
A. Yes. There are several options available. It is possible to get penalty abatement, installment agreement, currently not collectible status, and/or a statute of limitation review. A consultation will be needed to analyze your situation and recommend a solution.
- Q. What can you do that I can't do myself?  
A. Many taxpayers find the IRS intimidating and may give more information than required. It can be time consuming and frustrating. A qualified professional can usually save you money, time and stress.
